THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI,  
COUNTY OF JONES:

In consideration of Twenty five dollars and services hereinafter mentioned we convey and warrant to the Ellisville and Laurel R.R.Co. the following described real estate situate lying and being in the said County of Jones, in the State of Mississippi, to-wit:

The strip of land One hundred feet wide, being fifty feet on each side of center line of the Rail road of said Company as the same is now surveyed and to be located across the following lands, to-wit: Beginning 36 rods South of the NW corner of the NE1/4 of SW1/4 Sec.3 Township 7 Range 12 west thence running south on said subdivision line 15 rods thence East 12 rods thence North 15 rods thence west 12 rods to place of beginning being in Sec.3 Township 7 Range 12 west It is further agreed the further considerations of this deed is that said Ellisville and Laurel R.R.Co. shall take up and decently remove and reburry all the dead bodies buried upon said land at such places as the relatives of said dead bodies may select within the corporation limits of Ellisville a failure in any of the conditions and considerations aforesaid in this deed shall forfeit any right title and interest herein conveyed, reference being hereby especially made to the said survey of said railroad for a more accurate description of the land hereby conveyed with the right to cut down any and all trees which might fall upon said road, and the further right to do all necessary things for the adequate and proper drainage of said road provided the house of worship on said lot is not interfered with and repaired impracticable to worship therein.
